Sideline - Football (August - October/November) Basketball (December - February/March)

Sideline cheerleaders practice twice a week to prepare for games. While most games are on Saturday there is a possibility that schedules put together by The Prince Georges County Boys and Girls Club, will result in the need to cheer on alternative days.

Sideline cheerleaders will cheer for their corresponding age group. Depending on the number of teams cheerleaders may be required to cheer for additional teams.
